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OVERVIEW



Loddenhøj

0 KM 0 min

Our cozy little local area. There are several long walking/mountain bike trails here. We recommend walking down to Loddenhøj beach, and if you're lucky, you might spot the local seal, Luffe.



Aabenraa

14 KM
20 Min

This is the nearest larger town. In the center, you'll find cafés, restaurants, and shops. This is also where we strongly recommend you stop by Café Butler.



Kolding

62 KM
53 Min

A great option is to visit Kolding Storcenter, which has over 100 shops and restaurants. It's a good idea to check their website for events.



Odense

131 KM
1t. 41 min

This is the city we live in daily. Should you stop by Odense, we recommend spending a day at Odense Zoo, then head into the city center or Rosengård Center and finish with a meal.



Flensburg

53 KM

55 Min

They have a cozy pedestrian street and plenty of restaurants. If you're there during the Christmas season, Flensburg's pedestrian street is perfect for getting into the Christmas spirit. You can't go to Flensburg without shopping at the border stores on the way home. Remember to fill up your car – it's often 1-2 DKK cheaper per liter of fuel.



Billund

For families with children, we highly recommend setting aside a full day for a trip to Legoland. It's unfortunately a bit pricey, but it's worth the experience, especially for the kids.

Bonus:

- They are also known as the "Pancake House," which would be perfect to end the day with.



Legoland - LEGOLAND® Billund Resort

28 March -
December

Prices from: 349 dkk

- Buy tickets online – they're up to 170 DKK cheaper per ticket..

Opening hours: 10-20

- During the summer season, they're usually open until 8 PM.

Bonus:

- Drive to 25 Firhøjevej in Billund for easy parking. Unfortunately, parking is NOT free.



Odense ZOO - Soendre Boulevard 306, 5000 Odense C

Open almost all year.

Prices from 135 dkk

- Buy tickets in advance – the queue can be very long; this way you can skip it.

Opening hours: 9-20

- During the summer season, they're usually open until 8 PM.

Bonus:

- Parking is free and located right across from the zoo. Check feeding times and events in advance – there's almost always something for children.



Danfors Universe

28 March – 18 October

Prices from: 175,-

- Book online and save up to 45%

Opening hours: 10-17

- Opening hours vary a bit

Bonus:

One-day parking costs 60,- and can be paid upon arrival. It's possible to purchase food, free slush ice, and the opportunity to build a rocket. Book online.



RESTAURANTS



Loejt

Pizza Planet ★★★★★ ☆

Approx. 100
DKK per person
(excl. drinks)

This is our nearest dining option unless you want to go into Rødekro or Åbenrå. Their food is good compared to many other pizzerias. If you want to skip cooking and take something home after a long day of activities when mom and dad can't face the kitchen, this is a clear recommendation.

Aabenraa

Café Butler ★★★★★

Approx. 100-
200 DKK per
person (excl.
drinks)

Café Butler is the best dining spot in Åbenrå and the surrounding area. A family of 2 adults and 2 children can eat here without having to cancel their trip to Legoland. We can recommend their lunch steak or tapas if you're there for lunch. The children's menu isn't huge, but there should be something for all kids. Their tapas and 2/3-course menus change with the seasons, so you can always come more than once and still try something new. We recommend to book a table.



Genner

Pandekagethuset ★★★★★ ☆

Approx. 100
DKK per person
(excl. drinks)

If you've been to High Park, we 100% recommend stopping by, as your car is already parked in the lot. Yes, it's the same place, so it's perfect as a half/full-day trip. They have an extensive menu, both pancakes as a main course or dessert.

Roedekro

Roede - kro ★★★★★

Approx. 180-250 DKK per person (excl. drinks)

If you're into classic inn food and want to drive 20 minutes to eat, Røde-Kro is a great place to dine. Perhaps on the way home, as it's located at the same exit as the summer house.



Aabenraa

Restaurant Knapp ★★★★★

Approx. 200-300 DKK per person (excl. drinks)

If you're into fine dining, you won't be disappointed with Restaurant Knapp. Here you'll find everything from Wiener Schnitzel to oysters and caviar. They have seasonal menus from 2 to 6 courses. If that's not enough, you can get their signature experience: 6 courses, champagne with blinis and caviar, and an upgraded wine menu.

LOCAL PLACES TO SEE

The Local Beach

Our local beach, which is also connected to the campsite. It has the Blue Flag, so it's always nice and clean. There are toilets, fresh water, and a small kiosk where you can buy ice cream.



The Local Forest

We have a forest close to the summer house that is free to use. There are several trail systems, so you can go on a nice little walk without going more than 150m from the summer house.



Barsoe

Barsoe is a small island. It has a ferry connection from Barsø Landing on Løjt Land. So it's not far from the summer house. You can easily spend half a day on the island. It has a coffee house where you can get something to eat and drink. There are good swimming beaches and hiking trails.
